





## Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> November CONFERENCE DINNER

Palazzo Albergati Via Masini, 46 - 40069 Zola Predosa (Bologna)

The dinner will be held at Palazzo Albergati, a sumptuous and magnificent country dwelling named after the Bolognese family. It is one of the most important and original architectural works of the entire Emilian 17th century.

The building is surprisingly impressive due to its remarkable size and to the unusual contrast between the austerity of its exterior and the unexpected baroque space effect of its interior.

The interior is decorated and enhanced by a prestigious series of frescos, typical of the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> century Emilian school. During the 18<sup>th</sup> century, it was a very lively cultural centre of social life, which hosted popes, kings, princes, musicians, men of letters, scientists as well as famous adventurers
