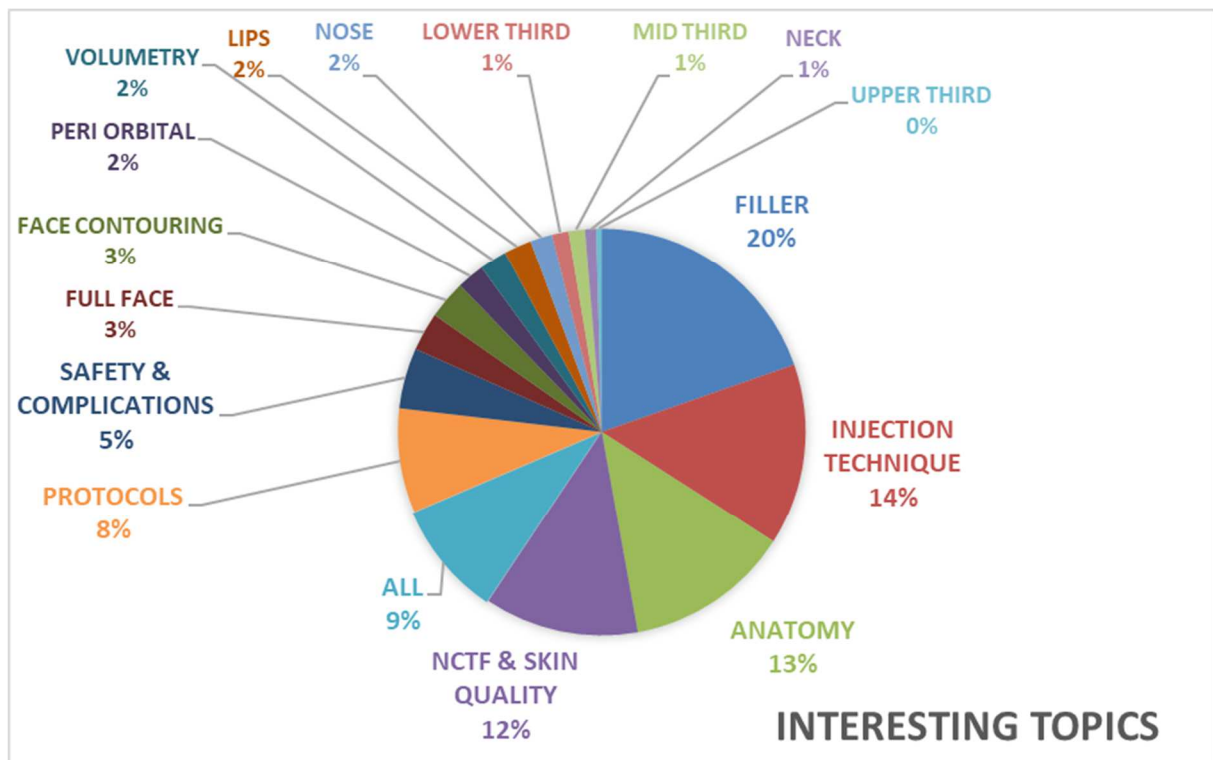
Rationale:
